## POSTPONED DUE TO THE UNPRECEDENTED NATURAL CALAMITY IN ORISSA

The revised dates for rssdi 99 will be announced after two weeks when the normalcy is expected to be restored in Bhubaneswar and Cuttack

The Organizing Committee met in an emergency meeting on November 5, 1999 at 4.00 pm and decided to postpone the conference to a suitable date in February/March 2000. The Organizing Secretary will despatch letters to all registered delegates which may take some more time as the communications may continue to remain disrupted.

A large number of delegates from many remote parts of the country have actively registered and made necessary arrangements to participate in rssdi 99 at Bhubaneswar.
