- To consider and adopt the following amendment to the constitution of the Research Society for the Study of Diabetes in India, as proposed by the Constitution/Credential committee and forwarded by the Executive Committee held on Friday, October 20, 2000 at 5.00 pm in Sunset Board Room, Hotel Oberoi Towers, Mumbai.
- 1.4 The aims and objectives of the RSSDI shall be:
- 1.4.10 i. To permit for formation of branches of the RSSDI at State and regional/local levels at different places of the country provided such request is made by at least 50 life members of the RSSDI from the place concerned. No person who is not a member of the RSSDI can be a member of any such branch. Such branches may charge a nominal fees from the RSSDI members of that locality as branch fees. Such branches can have a local registration done, if required, in the name of "R.S.S.D.I. Branch" only and not by any other name.
- ii. All such branches shall have branch Chairman, Branch Vice Chairman (one), Branch Secretary, Branch Joint Secretary cum Treasurer, and five members to their Executive Committee in a similar manner and similar responsibilities as narrated under 2.5 of the constitution. The election

to all such posts can be done during the annual general body meeting of the concerned branch, preferably to be held in the month of November or after a gap of one month following the Annual Conference of the RSSDI, as may be convenient.

N F W S

- All such branches shall have complete obligation to the RSSDI with regards to all matters including financial matters as described under relevant clauses of the constitution.
- iv. All such branches can undertake activities as described under 1.4 of the constitution except those categorised under 1.4.4, 1.4.5, 1.4.6 and 1.4.7, as such matters will only be dealt with by the RSSDI.
- v. All such branches have to submit details of their activities over the year to the Honorary Secretary, one month prior to the Annual Conference of the RSSDI. Excerpts of all such activities shall get due mention in the annual report of the Honorary Secretary. A synopsis of all such activities shall also be sent to the Honorary Editor of the IJDDC by the branch Secretary for consideration of publication in the Conference issue of the IJDDC.
- vi. There shall be a meeting of the Branch Chairmen and Branch Secretaries with the President, Secretary and other members to the EC during the Annual Conference of the RSSDI for any and all purposes that may be necessary.
- 7. To consider any other business with the permission of the chair.
- 8. To install the President of the Society for the year 2002 and, Vice Presidents, Secretary and Executive Members for the years 2002-2004.
