# RSSDI ACCREDITED CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM

Primary care physicians are invited for a post CME self assessment patterned after similar programs of IMA College of General Practitioners, IMA Academy of Medical Specialities (DSC) and the AKN Sinha Institute of Continuing Medical Education, IMA.

Clinicians with MB BS qualification after attending 100 hours of the RSSDI accredited CME programs wishing to attend the post CME self-evaluation in the School of Diabetology, Hyderabad may please write to the Honorary Secretary.

Self evaluation program also includes submission of 20 detailed case records with 2 IDDM and 2 GDM cases in the long case format as prepared for examinations in the teaching hospitals.

In addition, investigations, treatment given and follow-up should also be briefed. These records are to be neatly typed on A4 size white papers and spiral bound, and submitted at the time of self-evaluation program of the Accreditation.

Please note that for registering to the self assessment of the accreditation program (1) draft for Rs.1000 favoring 'diabetology' (2) copy of your M.B.,B.S. certificate, and (3) copies of accredited CME programs attended by you, should reach the Secretariat before December 17, 2000.

The date of the self assessment program is tentatively fixed for December 24, 2000 to be held in School of Diabetology at NIMS, Hyderabad for 2 hours between 12 noon and 2 pm. The self assessment will be to answer about 60 to 100 MCQs in two hours.

You are required to submit 20 case records neatly typed on A4 size papers and spiral bound, on the day of self assessment.

Accreditation is an attendance and self evaluation system of the continuing medical education activity for primary care physicians. It is not equivalent to a Certificate, Diploma or Degree awarded by the Universities, and it does not confer any academic qualification or distinction on a clinician.

#### INTERNATIONAL JOURNAL OF DIABETES IN DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

The Journal is not being published as per schedule, from mid 1997, but prior to this the publication of the Journal was fairly regular and per schedule. The chief reason for the present delay is paucity of material.

In order to rectify the situation we request medical teachers, researchers and scientists to send us a few articles a year for publication. These could be in the form of original articles or comprehensive reviews. If your busy schedule does not permit you to submit materials to us we would apprecite it if you could encourage other junior doctors to work under your guidance to submit their work for publication.

We would also like to inform you that we are in the process of getting our Journal approved by an abstracting agency. For this purpose, the secion on abstracts would have to be deleted from the Journal. However since this occupies quite a few pages, omission of this section would call for greater support from your side in the form of articles, reviews and case reports to maintain the current size and standard of the Journal.

We hope that you will support the Journal whole heartedly. This will ultimately help us all in projecting diabetology research from India on a global scale.
