The theme for the nutrition section at next years annual scientific meeting is "Protein in diabetic diets." Scope for investigation includes:

- * Biological qualities of proteins (vegetarians versus non vegetarians)
- * Specific proteins as insulin secretogogues (essential amino acids)
- * Satiety value of proteins (value in weight reduction)

In certain cases, quality or quantity of protein intake should be modified. What are the guidelines for modification in Indian conditions?

- Diabetic renal disease
- Diabetic pregnancy
- * Diabetes in childhood
