Minutes of the Research Society for Study of Diabetes in India (RSSDI) meeting 1991

Date: 8th November, 1991.

Venue: Conference Hall, AIIMS, New Delhi

- 1. Nearly 100 delegates and post graduate students attended the scientific deliberations. Prof. SP Tripathi, Director General, ICMR sent his inaugural address and message through an ICMR representative. Prof. HB Chandalia delivered the presidential address on "Protein glycation in diabetes mellitus". The 1991 SGP Moses awarded and oration was dedicated to International Study Group of Diabetes in Children and Adolescents (ISGD) and received on behalf of ISGD by Prof. J Ludvisson, Sweden (Title of oration: "Prediction and prevention of type I diabetes"). The theme papers focused on "Diabetes of young in India". The scientific papers presented during the free paper session, nutrition session, education session and lay session were well received.
- The members were very conscious of the lack of drive in terms of active participation and in increasing membership of RSSDI. They suggested formation of a committee to form the front line and improve the running of the RSSDI.
- 3. By consensus Prof. KC Samal, Cuttack was elected as President, RSSDI for the year1992.
- The venue of the 1992 RSSDI meeting was decided to be Cuttack or Puri under the leadership of Prof. KC Samal. Suggested theme was "Standards of diabetes care in developing countries".
- The annual subscription of Diabetes Bulletin will be revised by Prof. HB Chandalia. It was decided to encourage original reports. It was also suggested that the centre page should include

- position/consensus statements and important declarations of IDF, WHO, ADA and BDA.
- The meeting concluded with the felt need to invigorate the participation and involvement of the member in the activities of RSSDI.
